

B.S.P. S. AREA 4B POINTS AWARDS RULES 2009/2010

1. The season is from 1st October 2009 until 30th September 2010.
2. Ponies must be registered at the time of the class for which points are to be scored. They must currently be owned by an adult member of Area 4B and ridden by a member of Area 4B.
3. Members must notify either Headquarters or the Chairman of Area 4B **BEFORE** they may count points. Members may only belong to one area.
4. Points should be recorded on the official points cards and verified by either the secretary of the show, or a member of Area 4 B committee who **was at the show**. Committee members must not sign cards for their own ponies, or ponies their children ride. If you do not get your card signed or lose it you can verify your placings by asking the BSPS Office to send you a list of the pony's winnings and forwarding it with your card at the end of the season.
5. Points are awarded to the combination of pony and rider, a new card must be started if there is a change of ownership or rider. **A SEPARATE CARD IS NEEDED FOR EACH CLASS.**
6. The categories are :
SHOW PONIES -Lead Rein, Tiny Tots First Ridden, First Ridden, Three Open Height classes, one Intermediate, one Combined Novice.

WORKING HUNTER PONIES -Cradle Stakes, Nursery Stakes, Three Open Height classes, Intermediate, one combined Novice, **one combined Restricted.**

SHOW HUNTER PONIES -Lead Rein, First Pony of Hunter Type, Four Open Height classes, Intermediate, one combined Novice, **one combined Restricted.**

HERITAGE PONIES – POINTS WILL NOW ONLY COUNT FROM SHOWS ON THE LIST.
Lead Rein, First Ridden, one combined Novice Ridden, one combined Open ridden, one Combined Restricted Ridden, one combined novice WHP, one combined Open WHP, one combined Restricted WHP.

In mixed height classes points count as per rosette.

7. Points will only score at shows on the points list. See enclosed. Points as follows 1st 7, 2nd 6, 3rd 5, 4th 4, 5th 3, 6th 2, unplaced but completed the class 1 point.

Shows run by the Area count as double points.

8. In matters of dispute the decision of the Area Committee will be final.
