RULES & QUALIFICATIONS.

This is a qualifying show for the **BSPS Championships 2010**. Rules as per the 2010 Rule & Show Handbook. 1st & 2nd prizewinners in the following classes will qualify, 4-7, 21 - 23, 30 - 33, 34, 1st, 2nd & 3rd in Classes 3, 8, 17 - 18 & 36 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th in Classes 1 & 2, 11 - 16. **B.S.P.S. Best Rider**. The Best Rider in each of the following classes will be awarded the Best Rider card & qualify for the final at the summer Championships Show. 3 - 8, 17 - 20, 21 - 23, 30 - 34 & 36.

The "B.S.P.S. Challenge". The following will qualify L.R, F.R, Open Show ponies, Nursery Stakes, Open WH ponies, Open SH ponies, Open Intermediate SH, SRT & WH. The highest placed pony that has not qualified for the 2010 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class, will qualify. If the highest placed pony has already qualified for the BSPS Challenge the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony. If after qualifying for the Challenge a pony qualifies for HOYS it will forfeit its qualification for the "BSPS Challenge". **Cradle Stakes & Lead Rein of Hunter type**. The highest placed pony that has not qualified for the BSPS Challenge will qualify, if the highest placed pony has already qualified the qualification will go to the next eligible pony. The final will be held at the B.S.P.S. Summer Championships Show.

The B.S.P.S. Premier League. The qualification will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th placed ponies in the following classes 3, 15 - 16, 19 - 20

Royal International Horse Show. The highest placed pony not already qualified from the first five ponies in the following classes will qualify
5 - 8, 17 - 18, 22 - 25, 30 - 34 & 36.

Owners & riders must be B.S.P.S. members before the date of the show to compete in the classes with qualification for R.I.H.S. and animals must be registered with the B.S.P.S. except for the Anglo & Part-bred Arabs who must be registered with the AHS. Membership forms must be received in the office no later than the last working day (Monday - Friday) prior to the date of the show.

Blue Riband qualification. 1st & 2nd in Classes 5 - 7, 19 - 23, 30 - 33 & 34 will qualify and 1st, 2nd & 3rd in Classes 8, 17 - 18 & 36 will qualify.

This show is affiliated to the **SHB of Great Britain**. Rules as per the 2010 handbook. The organisers of the show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid & prevent accidents occurring & must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the Officials & Stewards.

RIHS qualifying classes - Classes 38 - 41 & 10 are qualifying classes for the RIHS 2010 and only horses registered on the 2010 register are eligible to enter. For Novice Hunters the rule states ".... not having won a prize of £60 or a total of £200....."

The National Hunter Supreme Show. The three highest placed horses in Classes 38 - 41 will qualify.

Class 9 the Novice Working Hunter class is a qualifying class for the **Lincolnshire Agricultural Society's** "Robert Goffin Working Hunter Championship" which will be held at the Lincolnshire Show on **22nd June 2011**. The three highest placed horses (not already qualified) from Class 9 will qualify for the Championship held at the Lincolnshire Show. Qualifier cards & rosettes supplied. Championship prize money to 5th place 1st prize £400, 2nd prize £150.

RIHS qualifying classes. Held under the rules of the **British Show Horse Association**. Horses must be registered with the association and all owners, exhibitors & riders must be Association members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. Classes 27 - 29, 45, 46, 48 & 49 are qualifiers for the RIHS. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward. In the Maxi Cob qualifiers the first three will qualify. Horse competing in Sport horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their affiliated shows cannot compete in hack and Riding horse classes at the same show. The three highest placed prize winners in all Open affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic supreme classes at the National Championships Show on September 10th & 11th 2010. The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider & amateur rosette in each open class and a Championship rosette for each section. The highest placed Amateur Home produced exhibit in all RIHS and HOYS qualifying classes will receive a Blue Chip rosette and £5 money-off voucher. The highest placed amateur will need to contact Sarah Butler by email sarah@bluechipfeeds.com or on 0114 266 6200 (a maximum of one rosette to be won at a RIHS qualifier and one rosette at a HOYS qualifier per horse. The award will then pass down the line.

Day tickets. Non members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 day tickets per exhibitor, per horse per season. A day ticket will allow entry into novice, Amateur, Young Rider, Home Produced, working and Open affiliated classes only but will not allow entry into RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes. Horses registered on a day ticket do not require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can purchase a day ticket from the BSHA office.

AMATEUR STATUS: A person is an amateur for showing purposes when showing ridden hunters if she or he does not:

- a) Engage in livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses as a means of deriving a main source of income since 1st January 2008.
- b) Accept remuneration whether it be monetary or goods in kind for employment in connection with horses in a racing, showing, livery stables or riding school. (Instruction at Pony Club or Riding Clubs excepted) since 1st January 2008.
- c) Show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm or a horse for which his or her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate concern since 1st January 2008.
- d) Show a horse which a professional rider has qualified in the weights or small ridden class for either HOYS or RIHS during the current year, unless the horse has subsequently re-registered under new ownership..
- e) Show a horse which is exhibited by a professional rider at the same show (except in a working hunter class on the same day).
- f) An amateur working hunter may not be ridden by a professional rider in a working hunter class on the same day.
Professional show persons may not enter the Amateur ring whilst the class is in progress.
- g) A professional rider must not ride or exercise an amateur's horse on the day it is competing in amateur classes.
