RULES & QUALIFICATIONS.

This is a qualifying show for the **BSPS Championships 2009**. Rules as per the 2009 Rule & Show Handbook. 1st & 2nd prizewinners in the following classes will qualify, 4-7, 14 & 15, 18-20, 34-37, 1st, 2nd & 3rd in Classes 1, 8, 21- 22 & 38, 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th in Classes 2 & 3, 11-12, 16 & 17. **B.S.P.S. Best Rider**. The Best Rider in each of the following classes will be awarded the Best Rider card & qualify for the final at the summer Championships Show. 1, 4-8, 14 - 17, 18-22, 32, 34-38.

The "B.S.P.S. Challenge". The following will qualify L.R, F.R, Open Show ponies, Nursery Stakes, Open WH ponies, Open SH ponies, Open Intermediate SH, SRT & WH. The highest placed pony that has not qualified for the 2009 Horse of the Year Show in the appropriate class, will qualify. If the highest placed pony has already qualified for the BSPS Challenge the qualification will be awarded to the next eligible pony. If after qualifying for the Challenge a pony qualifies for HOYS it will forfeit it's qualification for the "BSPS Challenge". **Cradle Stakes & Lead Rein of Hunter type**. The highest placed pony that has not qualified for the BSPS Challenge will qualify, if the highest placed pony has already qualified the qualification will go to the next eligible pony. The final will be held at the B.S.P.S. Summer Championships Show.

The B.S.P.S. Premier League. The qualification will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th placed ponies in the following classes 1, 3, 14-17.

Royal International Horse Show. The highest placed pony not already qualified from the first five ponies in the following classes will qualify 4-8, 18-24, 32, 34-38.

Owners & riders must be B.S.P.S. members before the date of the show to compete in the classes with qualification for R.I.H.S. and animals must be registered with the B.S.P.S. except for the Anglo & Part-bred Arabs who must be registered with the AHS. Membership forms must be received in the office no later than the last working day (Monday - Friday) prior to the date of the show.

This show is affiliated to the **SHB of Great Britain**. Rules as per the 2009 handbook. The organisers of the show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid & prevent accidents occurring & must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the Officials & Stewards.

RIHS qualifying classes - Classes 26 - 31 & 10 are qualifying classes for the RIHS 2009 and only horses registered on the 2009 register are eligible to enter. For Novice Hunters the 2009 new rule states ".... not having won a prize of £60 or a total of £200....."

The National Hunter Supreme Show. The three highest placed horses in Classes 26-31 will qualify.

Class 9 the Novice Working Hunter class is a qualifying class for the **Lincolnshire Agricultural Society's** "Robert Goffin Working Hunter Championship" which will be held at the Lincolnshire Show on **Wednesday 23rd June 2010**. The three highest placed horses (not already qualified) from Class 9 will qualify for the Championship held at the Lincolnshire Show on Wednesday 23rd June 2010. Qualifier cards & rosettes supplied. Championship prize money to 5th place 1st prize £400, 2nd prize £150.

This show is affiliated to the **British Show Horse Association**. All exhibits have to be registered with BSHA and all owners and riders have to be members of the BSHA. The following classes are held under the Rules & Jurisdiction of that society. Classes 39-45, 48 - 50. Classes 40-42, 44-45, 49-50 are qualifiers for the 2009 Royal International Horse Show. The highest placed exhibit not already qualified from the first three places will qualify. The first three in Classes 41-42, 44-45, 49-50 will qualify for the **Classic Supreme Classes** at the National Championship Show on September 11th & 12th 2009.

Novice Classes 39, 43, & 48 for a registered horse which has not won a 1st prize of £25 or more, or more than a total of £100 in any showing classes which were affiliated to the Association at home or abroad, prior to the 1st January 2009. Winnings gained as a four year old are excepted, unless the four year old won an Open class. A novice may be shown in a snaffle bridle. Exhibitors in **Novice Classes** may compete with a **day ticket**, for further details please contact 01462 437770. Day tickets allow you to compete in one show. You may have two tickets per year. JMB certificate is not required. You cannot enter RIHS or HOYS classes on a day ticket (you need to be a full BSHA member). **The National Championship Show**. All those placed in the first three in Open Cob, Riding Horse & Hack classes during 2009 qualify for the Supreme Classic classes to be held at the BSHA National Championships in September 2009.

Qualifiers for the North of England Summer Pony Show on 11th July 2009.

The **Open S.H.P. Champion** will qualify for the "**Leventhorpe Hall**" **Supreme Riding Pony Championship**. If the Champion has already qualified then the reserve Champion will go forward.

The **L.R. of H.T winner** will qualify for the "**Lilley**" **Supreme Mini Pony Championship**. If the winner has already qualified then the 2nd prize winner will go forward.

The **Open Riding Horse Champion** will qualify for the "**Deanwater Hotel**" **Ridden Show Horse Championship**. If the Champion has already qualified then the reserve Champion will go forward.

The **Open Intermediate Champion** will qualify for the "**Sporting Sam Supreme Intermediate Championship**". If the Champion has already qualified then the reserve Champion will go forward.

Classes 31 & 32 are affiliated to the **British Skewbald & Piebald Association** and are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show 2009.

These classes will be judged under BSPA rules and eligibility criteria. Further details from www.bspaonline.com or 01354 638 226. All horses & ponies must be registered and all owners & riders BSPA members prior to the show. Rider age taken from 1st January. All stallions must be graded and licensed with BSPA. No rider under 14 may exhibit a stallion in any class. Membership & qualification cards must be carried in the ring by the riders and produced as required for inspection or signature, failure to do so will mean disqualification. Spurs must not be worn in pony classes. All ponies 153cms & under (with exception of Shetlands & miniatures, which are exempt) must possess a current JMB certificate submitted to BSPA prior to the show. Qualification: 1st placed & the next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd qualify form each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3rd place.

- a) Engage in livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses as a means of deriving a main source of income since 1st January 2007.
- b) Accept remuneration whether it be monetary or goods in kind for employment in connection with horses in a racing, showing, livery stables or riding school. (Instruction at Pony Club or Riding Clubs excepted) since 1st January 2007.
- c) Show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial firm or a horse for which his or her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate concern since 1st January 2007.
- d) Show a horse which a professional rider has qualified in the weights or small ridden class for either HOYS or RIHS during the current year, unless the horse has subsequently re-registered under new ownership..
- e) Show a horse which is exhibited by a professional rider at the same show (except in a working hunter class on the same day).
- f) An amateur working hunter may not be ridden by a professional rider in a working hunter class on the same day.
- g) Professional show persons may not enter the Amateur ring whilst the class is in progress.
