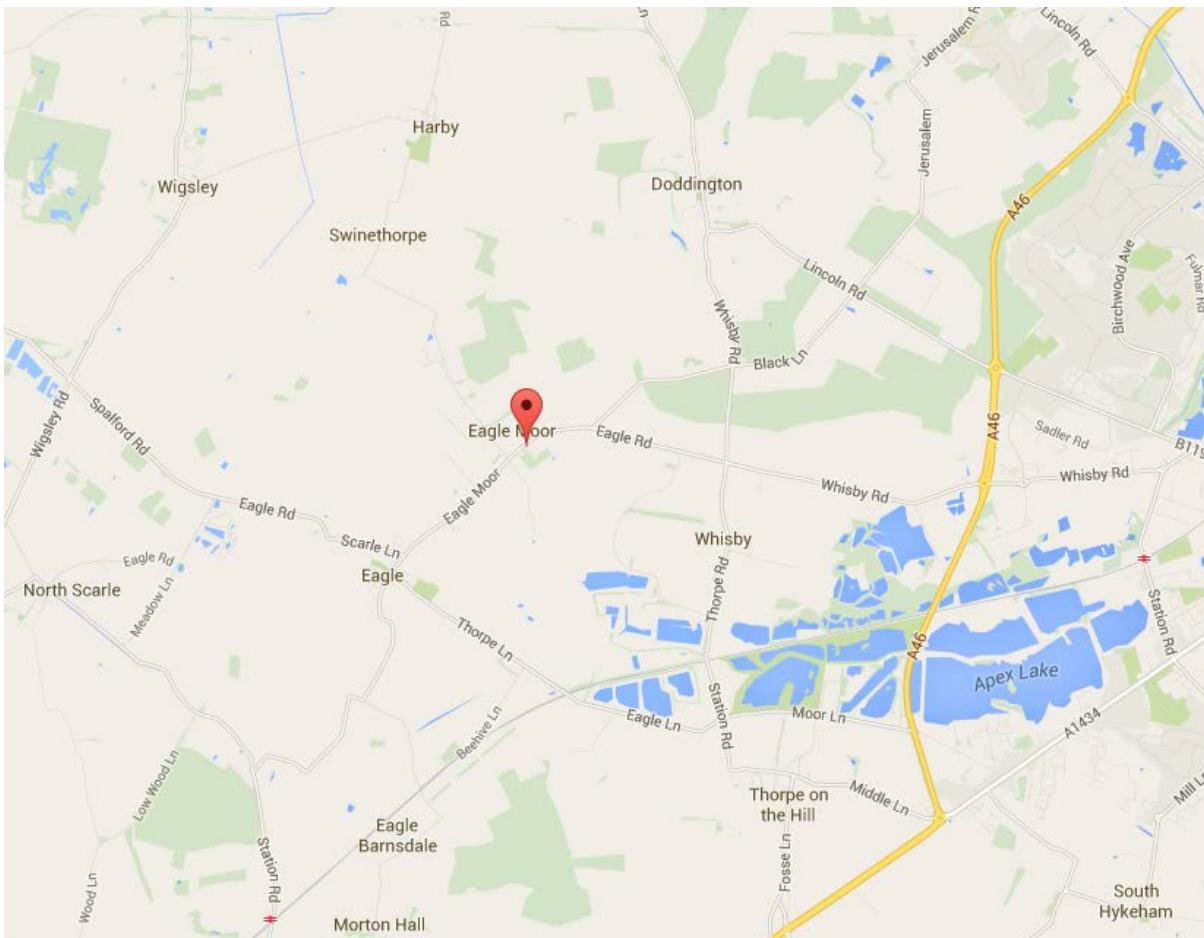
DIRECTIONS

To find us by road:

Eagle Moor is situated approximately 2 miles off the A46 between Lincoln and Newark. It is actually very easy to find and to stay on the main road is by far the easiest option rather than cutting across country - with the exception of anyone coming from the Dunham Bridge direction where it is quicker to cut through Doddington village. Also from the Newark direction, it is possible for 7.5 tonnes or less to cut through Thorpe on the Hill.

From Dunham Bridge direction - at the sharp left hand bend in Doddington village, take the right turn. Then take the first right at a small crossroads and right again at the T junction. If you miss the turn at the crossroads, it is not the end of the world as the next crossroads where you have to stop is not much further. Turn right there and we are on the right just as you see the Eagle Moor sign.

This is a qualifying show for the B.S.P.S. Summer Championships 2016. Rules as per the 2016 Rule & Show Handbook.

- *BSPS Summer Championships Show.* 1st & 2nd prize winners in classes 8, 9, 11, 12 1st, 2nd, & 3rd placed in Classes 7, 17-18 will qualify.
 - *BSPS Black Country Saddles Best Rider:* The Best Rider in Classes 7 - 13, 17-18 will qualify.
 - *BSPS Challenge* - see 2016 BSPS Rule & Show Handbook. Classes 7 - 13, 17 - 18
 - *The BSPS Premier League:* The qualification is awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 4th placed ponies in the following classes 7 - 13, 17-18.
 - 1st placed in Classes 17 & 18 qualify for the BSPS Heritage "Industrial Salt Supplies" WOW factor

- All competitors must wear a skull cap or hat and safety harness according to the current approved BSI or European Standard at all times.
 - No refunds or cancellation of entry fees permitted.
