RULES & QUALIFICATIONS.

This is a qualifying show for the B.S.P.S. Championships 2018. Rules as per the 2018 Rule & Show Handbook. 1st & 2nd prize winners in Classes 4-7, 49-52, 55-56, 63-67. 1st, 2nd & 3rd in Classes 8, 30-36, 60-62, 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th in Classes 1-3, 53-58.

B.S.P.S. Black Country Saddles Best Rider. The Best Rider in Classes 2-8, 30-36, 49-52, 53-55, 60-62, 63-68 will be awarded the Best Rider card & qualify for the final at the Summer Championships Show.

The "B.S.P.S. Classic Security UK Ltd Challenge". Animals will qualify by attending and B.S.P.S. affiliated show and by competing in the appropriate class. Ponies must not have qualified for HOYS 2017.

The B.S.P.S. Premier League. The qualification will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th placed ponies in the following classes that are not qualifiers for the RIHS, Classes 2-3, 53-55, 64-65.

Royal International Horse Show. The highest placed pony not already qualified from the first **three** ponies in Classes 4-8, 28-36, 43-48 49-52, 60-63, 66-68 will qualify. Owners & riders must be B.S.P.S. members before the date of the show to compete in the classes with qualification for R.I.H.S. and Blue Riband animals must be registered with the B.S.P.S. except for the Anglo & Part-bred Arabs who must be registered with the AHS. Membership forms must be received in the office no later than the last working day (Monday - Friday) prior to the date of the show.

Blue Riband qualification. 1st & 2nd in Classes 4-8, 49-52, 60-62, 64-68 will qualify.

This show is affiliated to the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain. Rules as per the 2018 handbook. Owners & riders have to be current SHB(GB) members in all ridden classes. The organisers of the show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the Health & Safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid & prevent accidents occurring & must obey the instructions of the organisers and all the Officials & Stewards.

RIHS qualifying classes - Classes 10, 12-17, are qualifying classes for the RIHS 2018 and only horses registered on the 2018 register are eligible to enter. Novice Working Hunter Rules state not to have won a total of £100 or 5 BE Points or 200 BS Points.

Day Ticket -this entitles competitors to compete at a maximum of 2 shows in the year - it covers owner and rider membership together with horse registration for these 2 shows. If the class is a qualifying class for RIHS, in order for the qualification to be valid, application for full owner/rider membership and horse registration must be received in the SHB(GB) office within 14 days. Day ticket £35 per ticket.

- **By order from Newark showground, all riders, whilst mounted, should wear hats or skull caps conforming to the current BSI or European standard.**
- **Working hunter. Open to mares, geldings, stallions (must wear red, white & blue ribbon in tail) 4yrs old & over exceeding 148cms to be judged in accordance with SHB of GB rules. Grade A show-jumpers & Advanced Event horses not eligible to compete in these classes. The maximum total points available is 100. This is made up of: Jumping points = Max 40 points, Style & Presence whilst Jumping = Max 20 points, Ride/Manners = Max 20 points, Conformation = max 20 points.**

AMATEUR STATUS: A person is an amateur for showing purposes when showing ridden hunters if she or he does not:

- Engage in livery, buying, selling, dealing or hiring horses as a means of deriving a main source of income since 1st January 2016.
- Accept remuneration whether it be monetary or goods in kind for employment in connection with horses in a racing, showing, livery stables or riding school. (Instruction at Pony Club or Riding Clubs excepted) since 1st January 2016.
- Show a horse owned or sponsored by a company or commercial form or a horse for which his or her immediate family accepts livery or training charges from a person outside the immediate concern since 1st January 2016.
- Show a horse which a professional rider has ridden in any ridden hunter or ridden Sport Horse class during the current year, with the exception of working hunter classes & ladies hunter classes unless the horse has subsequently re-registered under new ownership.
- Show a horse which is exhibited by a professional rider at the same show (except in a working hunter class on the same day).

Amateur Home Produced - Horses which are either stabled at home or in a DIY yard and which since 1st January 2018 have not been shown by a professional during the current season or stabled in a professional yard at any time in 2018. Must be ridden by an Amateur. This does not exclude the Amateur Owner Home Produced riders having lessons at any time with an instructor, providing the horse remains stabled at home or in a DIY yard.

- A professional rider must not ride or exercise an amateur's horse on the day it is competing in amateur classes.

ROYAL INTERNATIONAL HORSE SHOW ("RIHS")

*The Society designates certain Shows as qualifying shows for the RIHS at which horses may qualify for the RIHS in the current year or at specific shows for the following year. At these Shows the two highest placed horses in the Lightweight, Middleweight, Heavyweight, Small and Ladies (side saddle) Classes will qualify to enter at the RIHS. No horse lower than second will qualify. In the Working Hunter class the three highest placed horses will qualify. No horse lower than third will qualify. If there is a Working Hunter Championship made up of the first and second prize winners from the light and heavyweight working hunter classes respectively, these four horses will qualify for RIHS unless they have already done so. **Where there is only one amateur ridden hunter class the two highest placed smalls, the two highest placed lightweights, the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify. When there are two classes, in the lightweight section, the two highest placed smalls and the two highest placed lightweights will qualify and in the heavyweight section the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify.***

BSHA RIHS qualifying classes 18-24 are held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors & Riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15years of age or older. **REGISTRATION NUMBERS MUST BE QUOTED ON ENTRY FORM.**

These classes are qualifiers for the RIHS 2018. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward. Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in the Hunter sections of the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their affiliated shows cannot compete in Hack, Cobs & Riding Horse classes at the same show on the same day and vice versa. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes. The three highest placed prize winners in all Open affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic Supreme Classes at the National Championships Show September 2018. The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider & Amateur rosette in each Open class and a Champion rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse, Ladies Show Horse and HOYS Hunter classes)

The Association will award an Amateur Home Produced rosette in all Affiliated Open Cob (Lightweight & heavyweight only) class. These Cob rosettes have been kindly sponsored by TGS Mr Turley. The Awards will go down the line; there is no limit on how many of these rosettes can be claimed in a year.

Day tickets. Non Members may purchase up to a maximum of 2 Day Tickets per Exhibitor, per Horse, per Rider, per season. A Day Ticket will allow entry into Novice, Amateur, Young Rider, Home Produced, Working, In-Hand and Open affiliated classes only **but will not allow entry into RIHS or HOYS qualifying classes.** Horses registered on a Day Ticket do **not** require a JMB height certificate. Competitors can apply for a Day Ticket by downloading an application form, or apply online on the BSHA website.

Novice Hack. Cob & Riding Horses. A Novice is a BSHA registered horse (with exception of hunter) that has not won a first prize of £35, or more than a total of £250 (including Championship prize money) in any showing classes excluding Working Show Horses, Best Trained, Pairs, Side-Saddle, or In-Hand classes that were affiliated to the Association, at home or abroad, prior to the 1st January in the current year. Winnings gained as a four year old are exempt, unless that four year old has won an Open Ridden class with a first prize of £35 or more. Snaffle bridles may be worn in Novice classes.

Any exhibitor placed in the first three in Intermediate classes for Show Riding Type or Show Hunter Type may enter the Rising Stars class at the BSHA National Championships Show in September 2018. No qualifying cards are required.

The Open SHP Champion will qualify for the " *Michaela Wood* " **Supreme Ridden Pony Championship** on 7th July 2018 at the North of England Summer Pony Show. If the Champion has already qualified then the reserve Champion will go forward.

The L.R. of HT winner will qualify for the " *Colosso* " **Supreme Mini Pony Championship** on 7th July 2018 at the North of England Summer Pony Show. If the Winner has qualified then the 2nd prizewinner will qualify.

The Mini Show Pony Champion will qualify for the " *Colosso* " **Supreme Mini Pony Championship** on 7th July 2018 at the North of England Summer Pony Show. If the Champion has qualified then the Reserve Champion will go forward.

The Mini M&M Champion will qualify for the " *Colosso* " **Supreme Mini - Pony Championship** on 7th July 2018 at the North of England Summer Pony Show. If the Champion has qualified then the Reserve Champion will go qualify.

The Open Intermediate Champion will qualify for the " *Sporting Sam* " **Supreme Intermediate Championship** on 7th July 2018 at the North of England Summer Pony Show. If the Champion has qualified then the Reserve Champion will go forward.

The 1st & 2nd in the Amateur Show Hunter classes will qualify for the " *Royal Angel* " **Supreme Amateur Show Horse Championship** on 30th June 2018 at the North of England Summer Horse Show.

The Champion Ridden M&M will qualify for the " *Torne Valley* " **M&M Championship**. If the Champion has already qualified the Reserve will go forward to the North of England In-hand & M&M Show on 9th July 2017.

The Pretty Polly Champion will qualify for the " *Top Spec* " **Pretty Polly Championship** at the North of England Summer Pony Show on 7th July 2018. If the winner has already qualified the Reserve will go forward.

The Champion and Reserve Champion Coloured will qualify for the " *The Vanguard Property Holdings* " **Supreme Ridden Coloured Championship** to be held at the North of England show on 8th July 2018.

The Champion & Reserve Champion Anglo/Part-bred will qualify for the " *Colosso Family* " **Supreme Ridden Part-bred & Anglo Arab Championship** to be held at the North of England Summer Pony show on 7th July 2018.

B.S.P.A. RIHS QUALIFIERS: These classes are affiliated to the British Skewbald and Piebald Association and are qualifiers for the Royal International Horse Show, Hickstead, Tuesday 24th July 2018. Classes will be judged under BSPA rules. Download from www.bsponline.com. All horses/ponies must be registered and all owners and riders BSPA members prior to the show. Rider age taken from 1st January. Membership and qualification cards must be carried in the ring by competitors and produced as required for inspection or signature. Failure to do so will mean disqualification. Spurs may not be worn in any pony class. Ponies 153cm or under (Shetlands exempt) must possess a current JMB height certificate.

All stallions must be graded and licensed by BSPA or hold a BSPA Showing Permit (contact BSPA for Stallion showing permit information) for 2018 and have a BSPA stallion ID card and wear BSPA Stallion ID Disc. No rider under 14 may exhibit a stallion in any class. No competitor / owner / horse may compete in this class or enter the ring without current 2018 Membership of BSPA and a RIHS qualification card. Qualification: 1st place and the next unqualified competitor standing 2nd or 3rd qualify from each class. No competitor may qualify from lower than 3rd place. Highest placed Amateur and highest placed Junior in each class qualify for Amateur and Junior Supreme Championships Final to be held at the BSPA World of Colour Championship Show 2018 at the College EC, Keysoe, Bedfordshire. Cards to be shown and qualification signed in the ring. All Champion & reserve Champion winners qualify for the BSPA Star Championship at WCC.

All horses & ponies must be registered with BSPA all owners/riders members of BSPA prior to entry and membership+ qualification cards must be carried into the ring and signed at the time of qualification in the ring by the Judge. Failure to comply with the rule will mean disqualification
